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Arrival / Check-In Procedures

- You may arrive and set up camp during daylight hours between 12:00 PM EST and 6:00 PM EST on Friday, September 1.
- Note the time change from CST to EST results in the loss of 1 hour during travel.
- Check-in will be on the main camp road just inside the gate. The entrance will be available throughout the weekend for ease of entry and exit. As you approach the gate with your car, it will automatically open and close behind you.

Vehicles & Parking

Vehicles

- Only (1) vehicle can be left at campsite. Please don't park on road to block traffic. Speed limit for ATVs is 10 mph in campgrounds.
- RV/Camper/Pop Up/Motor Coaches are allowed.
- Campers up to 30 ft in length or less are allowed. Anything larger needs to park in the designated RV parking area.
- ATVs are allowed. They may be ridden only on the groomed path at no more than 10 mph or in the ATV riding areas during designated hours.

Parking

- Only (1) vehicle can be left at a campsite. Please don't park on road to block traffic.

Meals

- Bring your own snacks, meals and drinks. Meals will not be provided.
- Fire pits are available for cooking. Bring your own firewood.
- Grills are allowed.

Water / Ice

- Two water wells are available. First well is located at Palooza Road and Monument Road with the second at Vertical road and Wolfpack Way (See Map).
- Ice is available at Town Square. \$5.00 per bag self-serve.

Noise Curfew

- There is a noise curfew at 11:00 PM EST each night.

Prohibited Items

- NO pets
- NO fireworks or explosives
- NO alcohol
- NO firearms

Campsites

- Tent campsites are approximately 30 ft x 30 ft and can accommodate 5-8 men in 3-5 tents.
- Please stay in your site. Do not borrow items from other campsites. Respect other sites.

Electricity

- No electricity is provided onsite. You must provide your own generator if you desire electricity.
- Generators may be used and must be placed at least 50ft from tent campsites.

Fire pits

- May have a 3ft x 3ft fire pit lined with stone or other border material
- Bring your own firewood. Firewood will not be provided.
- All fires to be fully extinguished before leaving camp on Monday

Trash

- Trash pick-up is twice daily after lunch and after dinner
- Bring your own supply of trash bags
- Place all trash in sturdy bags curbside
- On Monday, trash pick-up will begin at 12:00 PM EST

Bathrooms / Showers

- Port-a-potties are located throughout the campsite area.
- Shuttle Service will be provided to the showers in the morning starting at 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM. Pick up and drop off will be on the amphitheater vertical hillside.

Departure / Check Out Procedures

Check Out Procedures

- Campsites must be cleared, cleaned, and returned to their original condition
- Clean up all garbage
- Clean up fire pit (put out all fires)
- Clean up all gear
